The organising committee had the major responsibility for the practicalities associated with the setting up the workshop. Announcements were drawn up and circulated, and the criteria governing paper selection based on an extended abstract defined. An email list comprising nearly 600 addresses was the basis for distributing the first announcement. As the abstracts arrived, they were sent to members of the organising and scientific committees for evaluation. Of the 74 abstracts received, 30 were rejected as being unsuitable for the objectives of the workshop and 44 invitations to write a full paper were sent out. In response, 39 draft papers were received and 5 papers withdrawn. All the draft papers were sent to the appropriate members of the expert writing group (plus a few external contacts) for critical review. All 39 papers were subsequently finalised by the authors. In addition, each keynote speaker provided a full-length paper to accompany his/her presentation.

Session chairmen were chosen from members of the organising and scientific committees. Summaries of the sessions have been subsequently written by them, and appear in Annex II. They are also responsible for transferring to the writing group's document any new information presented during the session which can contribute to the assessment matrix being constructed by the group.

GRS Garching hosted the workshop, and provided the infrastructure and staff necessary to support it. The local organiser took responsibility for all matters relating to local arrangements, including allocation and equipping of lecture rooms, the production of the hand-outs, for organising refreshments, lunches and evening programmes for delegates and accompanying persons, transport and accommodation, and for keeping the registrations and accounts in order.

The workshop took place over 2½ days from 5-7 September 2006.
